

Computer Requirements

The ACAF program courses are delivered entirely online through CPA Canada's Learning Management System, D2L (Desire2Learn).

Examinations will be written using laptop computers. You will be required to bring your laptop computer to an invigilated examination centre, with the necessary software installed and tested, on the scheduled exam day/time. Additional information will be provided prior to the exam.

Required software

Required hardware for the exams

- PC based laptop computer. **No Apple/Power PC/Macintosh computers will be allowed during examinations, even if they run Windows.**
